DATA LEAK

Chat apps are out of the jurisdiction of the company. Groups, members, work progress and files exchanged are often not transparent to the management.

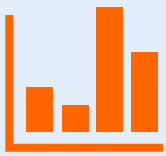
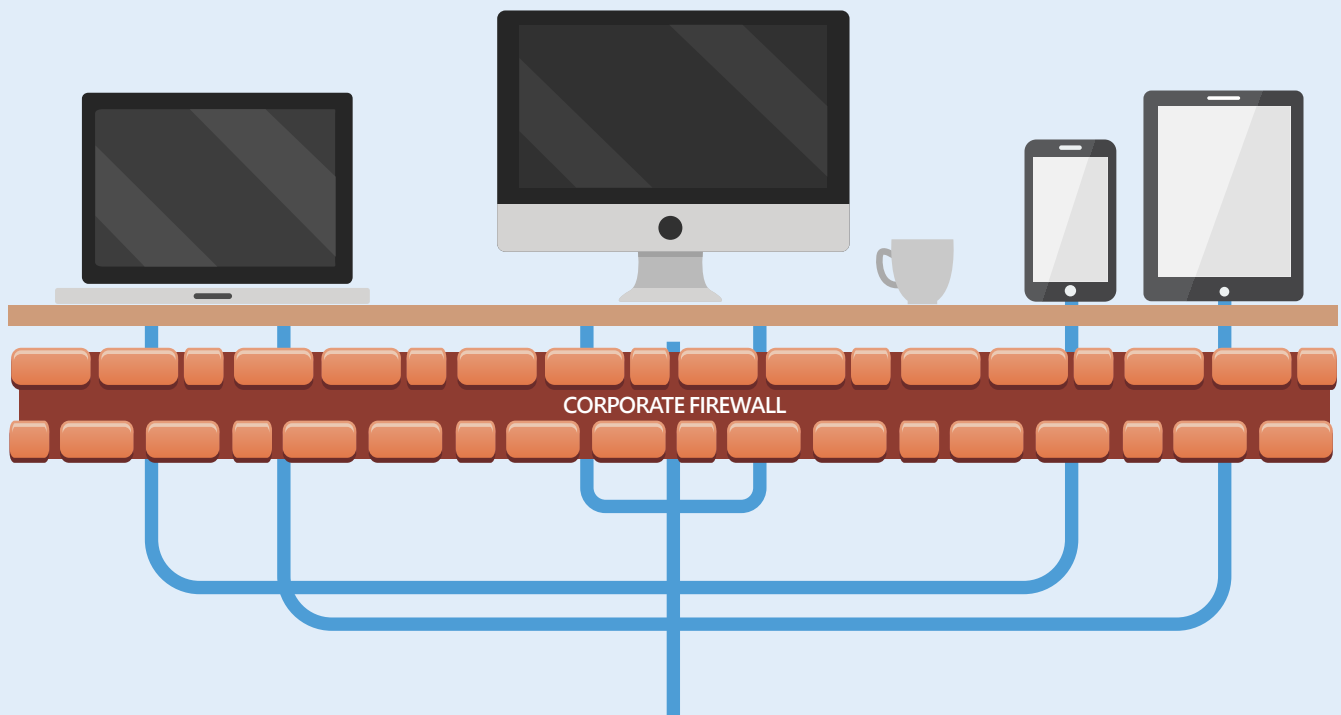


POOR PERFORMANCE

Once your data enter the cloud, it's copied and become their assets. You may opt out by rejecting the user agreement and quitting the service.

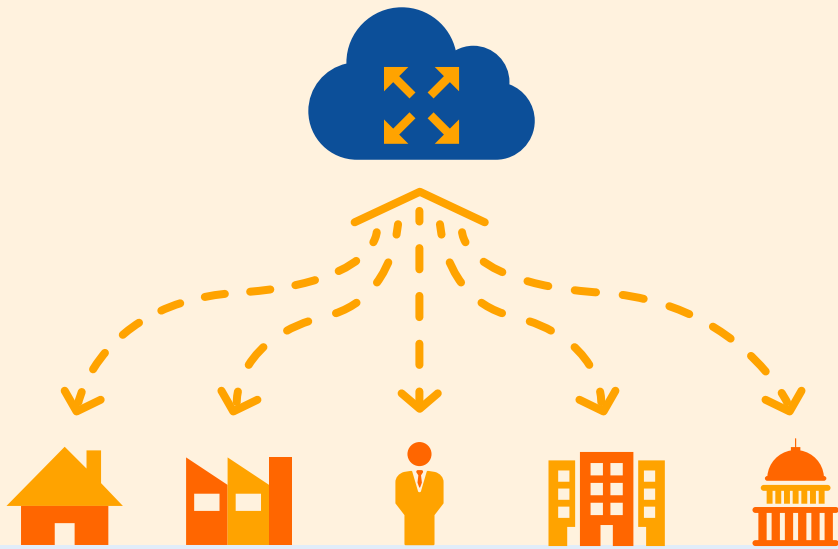


SECURITY CONCERNS

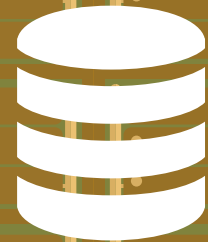
TRACK PROGRESS

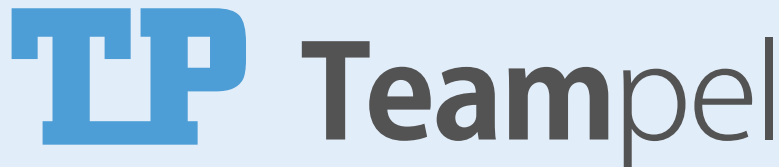

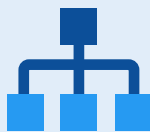
